*\$1.5 MILLION G1 WINNER*  
**SMILING TIGER**

Multiple G1 winner at 3 and 4 won his 2-year-old debut in May by six lengths in :46.39, his stakes debut by eight lengths then placed in the **Del Mar Futurity-G1** and **Best Pal Stakes-G2**. Two-year-olds in training from his first crop of 72 foals are catalogued to sell at Barretts' March 29th Select Sale at Del Mar. **Fee: \$4,000 LF**



*GRADE I SIRE*  
**TIZBUD**

Ranked among the **Top 10** California sires of 2016 by average earnings per runner (\$27,676) and earnings per start (\$4,222), **Tizbud** sired three major stakes winners in California last year from 36 starters: **Ambitious Brew (G3, \$449,225)**, **Soi Phet (\$756,816)** and 3-year-old **Chao Chom** who defeated **Enola Gray** at Del Mar. **Fee: \$2,500 LF**



*G2 MILLIONAIRE*  
**CLUBHOUSE RIDE**

**Candy Ride's** leading money winner at stud is a multiple G2 winner of \$1,341,132 who won or placed in 15 stakes and 11 graded races from 6 to 10 furlongs over five racing seasons, including the **Santa Anita Handicap-G1**, **Gold Cup at Santa Anita-G1** and **CashCall Futurity-G1**. His first foals are yearlings of 2017. **Fee: \$2,500 LF**

**DESERT CODE**

With progeny earnings surpassing \$1 million for the second consecutive year in 2016, **Desert Code** ranked among the **Top 10** active sires by Cal-bred progeny earnings. Eleven 6-figure earners from his first two crops include 2016 stakes winner **Bad Ju Ju (\$309,731)**, 2017 stakes-placed **Desert Steel (\$272,779)** and 12-time winner **Desert Madam (\$265,411)**. **Fee: \$2,000 LF**

Graded-placed Santa Anita stakes winner and brilliant turf sprinter retired with earnings of \$318,910 with 5 wins and 4 seconds in 11 starts.
