TAPIT to Enter Stud in California

PROSPECT PARK



In an impressive turf debut, **PROSPECT PARK** won the **La Jolla Handicap-G3** by 4 1/4 lengths in 1:41.54 while posting a **103 Beyer** for the 1 1/16 miles. He completed the final sixteenth of a mile in 5:86.

Retired with earnings of \$539,770, **PROSPECT PARK** hit the board in 14 of 18 starts, winning or placing in six graded stakes.

Second in the **San Felipe Stakes-G2** following a 5 1/4-length allowance victory at Santa Anita, **PROSPECT PARK** was considered a leading West Coast classic contender in 2015 but was sidelined with a virus after a fourth-place finish in the **Santa Anita Derby-G1**.
